FROM OUR CHAIRPERSON AND VICAR FOR DEVELOPMENT

Along with the Catholic schools and academies in our Diocese, Futures in Education began the 2020-21 school year with hope and resolve. Our schools opened safely with full-time, in person instruction, when so many of their neighboring schools struggled. For our students and their families, so hard hit by this pandemic, what a blessing to continue to receive the gift of a Catholic education during such a perilous time. This year, we were able to provide more than \$7 million dollars in scholarships to support the hopes, dreams and futures of so many students and families in need. This gift could not have been realized without the generosity of so many of our Futures in Education donors. Thank you.

In the spring of 2021, our Futures in Education family felt a great loss with the passing of our original Angel, John Loconsolo, who passed at 101 years of age. Over the years, John was a dedicated supporter of the Be an Angel to a Student, program, sponsoring over 100 students a year, and donating more than \$2.5 million dollars to the Angel program through the Victoria Loconsolo Foundation. In honor of his legacy, the Board of Trustees created an initiative to sponsor 101 new Angel students commemorating his years on this earth. In memory of John, we surpassed our goal.

We are thrilled to announce that we began the 2021-2022 school year with an increase in diocesan Pre-K –8th grade Catholic elementary schools for the first time in more than a decade! Our students and schools stand strong, and we have you to thank. You have helped change many lives, and your help will continue to strengthen our Church far into the future. And, our Be an Angel to a Student program continues to grow, with a 20% year over year increase in donations from our Angels.

Thank you again to our Board members, donors, principals and Academy boards, for bringing the profound and important mission of Futures in Education to life. Thanks to your diligence and unwavering support we were able to give the gift of Catholic education to **the neediest of students in Brooklyn and Queens**. 
Connecting and Engaging

Since 2009, Futures in Education has helped 54 participating elementary schools and academies reconnect with alumni and raised \$3 million from 30,000 gifts through the School Development program in conjunction with Catholic Alumni Partnership (CAP). Each of the parish schools engaged in the strategic initiative of Preserving the Vision. Now, almost all schools function using an academy model governed by their own board of directors.






